Throughout the spring and summer we will be studying the book of Hebrews together. It's the book of Hebrews that reveals to us the gracious truth that Christianity is not a religion, but the announcement of the end of religion. Additionally, it reveals that no amount of religious practice or experience will redeem us. The book of Hebrews is about the great and true Hebrew, Jesus. What matters is a living faith relationship with Jesus. This faith is not a Sunday thing; faith matters in all areas and outlooks on life. Faith encompasses everything from our understanding of how the world came to be, to how we came to be, to how we came to be made right. With all these great claims, perhaps we are puzzled by the underwhelming start to the book. In chapter 1, the author begins to reveal the greatness of Jesus by comparing him to angels of all things. Hebrews 1 teaches that Jesus is greater than angels. But didn't we already know that? What could this mean for us?

Next Sunday

We look this week at Hebrews 2: Salvation comes 'Not by Religious Escape but by the reconciliation of Jesus'. The Christian faith isn't just a bunch of rules and pronouncements about what to do or not to do. It's based in the person and work of Jesus. Religion says, Do it this way and a human can become like a god. Christianity says, God became one of us, a human. In that reconciling work of Jesus, salvation is found. Jesus is 'not ashamed' to call you a brother or a sister. What an amazing grace that is.
